Dear Mr. Hansen:

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has reviewed the Wildlife Hazard Site Visit Report (WHSV) for Redfield Municipal Airport (1D8) located in Redfield South Dakota. The site visit and report were conducted and prepared by Midwest Wildlife Services, LLC.

Based on our review, FAA has accepted the WHSV and recommends the development of Wildlife Hazard Management Plan (WHMP). The WHMP will incorporate the findings, recommendations, and concerns that are identified and discussed in the WHSV. To ensure the WHMP is fully developed to address the identified hazardous wildlife issues at 1D8 we recommend using the criteria outlined in the draft Advisory Circular 150/5200 XX Protocol for the Conduct and Review of Wildlife Hazard Site Visits, Wildlife Hazard Assessments, and Wildlife Hazard Management Plans. Prior to implementing, our agency will need to review and accept the WHMP.
